

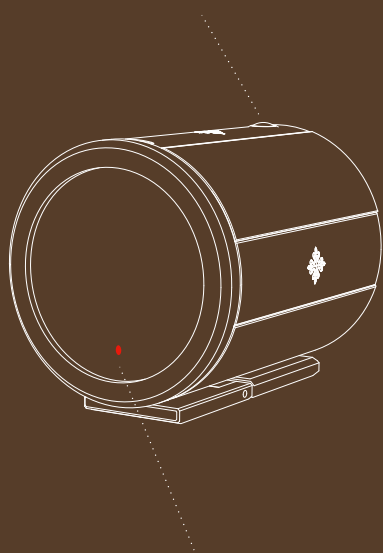

Watch Winder Technical Specifications

On/Off Button

Stays in the "pressed" position to indicate its active status

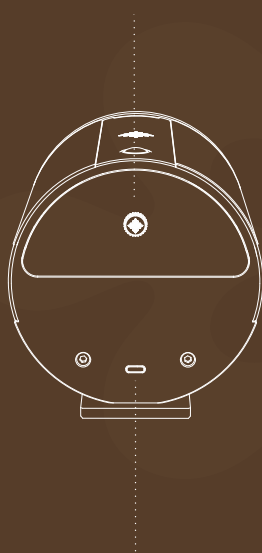


Low battery indicator

Activates only when the battery level drops below a specified percentage

Battery compartment

Powered by six standard AA non-rechargeable batteries



USB-C connection

Compatible with standard 5V adapters; provides power when batteries are low

Key Features:

- The programme winds at 1.600 rotations per day (800 right + 800 left)
- Gentle movement at 11 rotations per minute
- Efficient regular winding with 6 minutes of rotation per hour (right + left), followed by a 54-min pause
- Speed-winding during the very first hour after pressing the On/Off button to ensure a minimum 10-hour power reserve
- A rest phase during the second hour, followed by regular winding for the next 14 hours
- The automatic sleep phase starts after 16 hours of operation; the watch winder will automatically pause for the following 8 hours
- All subsequent 24-hour cycles consist of 16 hours of regular winding followed by an 8-hour sleep phase
